## ECONOMIC IMPACT

CAE remains a major economic driver for South Carolina and the Midland's region. Receiving no state or local tax dollars since June 1982, CAE is 100% self-sufficient. ## GREEN INITIATIVES

With the development and installation of a solar farm on five acres of airport property, CAE has been designated as a certified green business. The solar farm enables CAE to receive yearly rebates, offsetting annual electrical costs by an average of \$279,987.



## AIR CARGO

In 2019, CAE was the 57th airport in the U.S. for cargo operations. This was a 10 year high at CAE. In 2021, CAE saw an increase of 14% in landed weight cargo over 2019 at 547 million lbs.
